As a postgraduate student, you are automatically a member of the Middle Common Room, or the MCR for short. The MCR is a diverse community of postgraduate students who cover all academic disciplines and come from lots of different backgrounds and walks of life. The MCR is also a physical space within College comprised of a common room and a study room. The common room is stocked with tea, coffee, and biscuits and there are boardgames, a Nintendo Switch, an Xbox, and TV which members are welcome to use. Wednesday 20th September

Thursday 28th September


15:00-c.16:00: Tour of Durham — If you weren't able to make the tour last week, this is your chance to get to know Durham a little better. Meet in the MCR.
